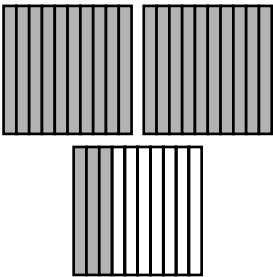


# Mixed Numbers and Decimals

Two whole squares and  $\frac{3}{10}$  of a third square are shaded.

2.3

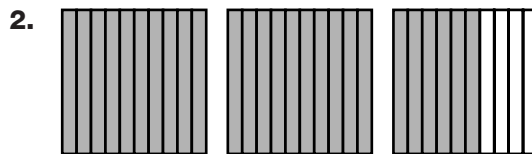
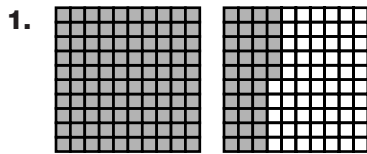
**Read and write the numbers in word form.**
